Impurrtant Cat-Etiquette for visitors

A calm and peaceful environment makes us purr

- please note: There are live cats here! If you have allergies or any such concerns, please do not choose to enter the CatAviary enclosure
- No more than 9 people inside the CatAviary at a time
- Kids must be supervised by an adult
- No rough-housing with kitties or art work!
- Please be mindful: cats can be stressed by loud noises (so please do any screeching, crying, or barking outside!)
- Be a pussycat and respect the kitties' space. Do approach them gently but don't crowd them
- Please respect the artwork. If you are not a cat, do not handle it, sit on it, or step on it! Do not sit on the Cat Stairs or step on the Cat-nap Mats. You are welcome to sit on the benches provided or on the floor!
- If you would like to adopt a purr-former (and we hope you do!) applications are available from gallery staff or volunteers. They are processed by Kitten Rescue according to their usual protocol and there is a 48-hour waiting period
