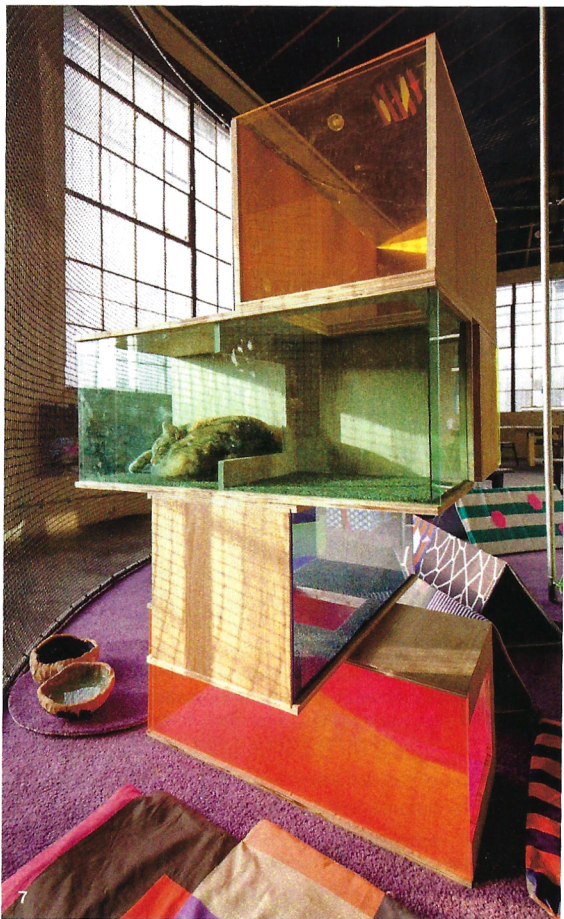

"THE CATS-IN-RESIDENCE PROGRAM" (356 S. MISSION RD., LOS ANGELES) This captivating sculptural installation—cum—rescue project, which originated at White Columns in New York, was conceived by Rhonda Lieberman and assembled from works by Lisa Anne Auerbach, Jonathan Horowitz, Rochelle Feinstein, and Ruth Root (among many others), and housed in a so-called CatAviary designed by Freecell Architecture and Gia Wolff. The work included a host of feline residents who played, cavorted, and hid among its pipes, towers, and steps. Visitors could also take home a new friend from partner Kitten Rescue, and twelve "purr-formers" were adopted.
